Dear Friends,

Three decades ago, Pace Center for Girls opened its doors with the understanding that all girls, no matter their circumstances, have value, strength, and enormous potential. This principle remains foundational today through our advocacy work, program delivery, and the unwavering belief that there is great in every girl and that together we find it.

This work requires a clear vision, teamwork, trust, and a caring community. It requires agility, innovation, and a commitment to learning. And the benefits are enormous.

This past year we had the opportunity to help more than 3,000 girls change their life trajectories and become the architects of a better future by finding the great in themselves. Over the course of the year, we opened our 20th Pace Center in Hernando County. We expanded the successful Reach model to eight counties across Florida, providing much needed counseling, case management, and mental health services to girls in schools and the community. And we continue to lay the foundation to expand what we have accomplished in Florida in other states.

Over the past several years, we have also had the opportunity to work with our elected officials to help change systems and policies that stand in the way of girls' success, and this work has contributed to a 50 percent decrease in the number of girls who are involved in the juvenile justice system across the state. Why does this matter? It matters because our Pace girls are our next generation of mothers, community leaders, and workforce, and when they are successful, we all benefit.

We are grateful for the support from donors, volunteers, partners, and our staff. Your continuing support makes everything we do possible. It is what inspires us to do more, to never give up on our girls, and to never let them give up on themselves.

DANIELA'S STORY



“The encouragement and empowering messages I received at Pace helped me overcome my past trauma and provided me with the confidence I needed to make my dreams a reality”

For me, the Pace program has been a life-changing experience. I grew up in what most would consider a traditional family environment. My mother was a teacher, and my father worked in law enforcement, but behind closed doors were a lot of issues between my parents. These traumatic issues at home influenced my behavior and led me to my involvement with the juvenile justice system at the age of 12.

I was sent to other diversionary programs, but none of them did more than deal with surface issues. Finally, my juvenile probation officer referred me to Pace. I always knew I wanted a better life. Despite the issues in my home, my parents always instilled in me the importance of education. I needed to find a place that would ground me and give me the direction I desperately needed. This was my last hope for redemption.

When I got to Pace I was just there for myself. I wasn't interested in making friends. But, eventually I learned that working together and not having to compete all the time made me and the other girls stronger as young women. Pace is unique. And as an all-girls program we learned to come together and lean on one another. Pace provided me the necessary tools to develop and grow. The staff and counselors truly cared. They worked to get to the root of my issues and allowed me to express myself creatively.

The encouragement and empowering messages I received at Pace helped me overcome my past trauma and gave me the confidence I needed to make my dreams a reality. With Pace's help emotionally and financially, I completed a double major in Women's Studies and English as well as a certificate in Global Black Studies. I'm currently working on my master's degree in African and African Diaspora studies. My goal is to complete a PhD in Sociology and work in higher education.

Pace is an amazing organization with amazing donors. The financial seeds donors sow lead to tremendous growth. While they don't always get to see this personally, that growth happens every day. I am so grateful to the donors for what they have provided to me, including a scholarship toward my education. I hope one day when I am more established I can return that gift to another Pace girl.

Pace's program and talent focused on innovation and growth during FY18, while still holding strong to our roots to ensure serving our girls remained our first priority and our outcomes supported our philosophy. We focused specifically on codifying our Foundational Pillars as well as defining our culture. This work led to the creation of organization-wide initiatives to train all staff around our pillars (strength-based, trauma-informed, gender-responsive) and how they work through these pillars within each of their roles. Our culture work has been very intentional to ensure Pace has a culture of Purpose, Learning, Caring, and Results. Our girls have been an integral part of creating and defining what this looks like within center life as well as through our Reach program. Below are examples of initiatives developed as a result of this year's focus on innovation and growth through our Foundational Pillars and culture work:

- **Statewide Girls Leadership Council**
Girls representing all 20 centers gathered in Jacksonville to engage in two days of formal leadership development.
- **Listen-for-Good Initiative Expansion**
Listen-for-Good is an initiative to obtain feedback from those one serves. It uses the Net Promoter Score (NPS) as the tool to gather and quantify feedback. Pace has been using the NPS with girls for several years and has now expanded to include feedback from parents and caregivers. The information obtained from this survey is invaluable in our ability to ensure we are meeting the needs of our girls and our communities.
- **Wellness Program for Staff**
The PaceFit program was expanded to include education, activity challenges, and self-care guidance in an effort to minimize the impact of secondary trauma to our staff so they can be fully present to serve our girls.

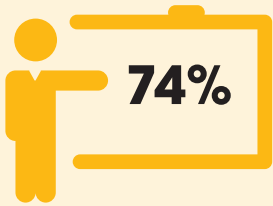

"When I was a sophomore in high school, I was sexually assaulted by a boy in my school. It was traumatizing. I started skipping school to avoid

seeing him, which caused me to fail classes and eventually led to self-harm and thoughts of suicide. It was a really hard time in my life.

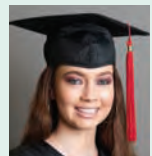
But in just 13 months at Pace, I completed two full years of high school and graduated with my high school diploma at just 16 years old! I really feel like my quick turnaround was because of the individual attention, self-paced curriculum, mental health support, and the sisterhood I found at Pace. I don't know if I would even be alive today without Pace. Now, I'm working at a doggy daycare, while attending Pensacola State College's Vet Tech Program."

"Before I came to Pace in 2016, I was struggling academically and dealing with a lot of family issues. So, I voluntarily left my old

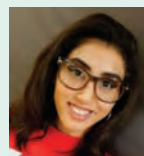

As I earned my GED through the Reach Enrichment Lab, I was also able to work with a Pace Reach Therapist who helped me work through my anxiety and depression struggles. Pace also helped me strengthen my communication skills, which has really helped mend my relationships with my family members. Now, I am a high school graduate and working full time at J. Alexander's Restaurant, while I plan to study abroad and one day own my own business."

"Before becoming a Pace girl, I had lost hope of completing school and felt I had exhausted my educational options. I stopped attending school completely and attempted suicide several times. The last attempt was successful. I was completely unresponsive when discovered. Thankfully, first responders were able to resuscitate me. After recovering in the hospital, I visited Pace in Clay County. I knew it was a great opportunity for me, and I started the next day.

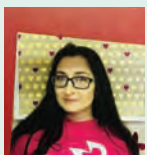

Delia - Collier

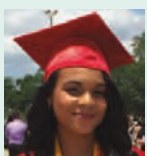
"I came to Pace Collier in the ninth grade with a broken heart, both emotionally and physically. I had fallen behind in school and

After a long stay at the hospital, I started at Pace, and it was the best decision I've ever made. They understand me, have helped me get back on track, and are teaching me how to achieve the goals I have set for myself. Now, I don't quit until I reach them. I am so grateful to Pace for everything it has offered me."

"When I was 17, I lost someone really important to me. I didn't know how to cope with the pain, so I just stopped going to school. Determined to graduate and get the help I needed, I chose to start at Pace Hernando. It's been an amazing experience. I serve on the leadership council and have even won awards for helping out other girls who are struggling. Now, I can see a future ahead of me. I am going to graduate on time and am hoping to study neuroscience in college."

"When I came to Pace, I was on the verge of dropping out of high school in the same way my parents and siblings had done before me.

When I walked through those doors, EVERYTHING changed. I became more optimistic about my future. I knew someday I wanted to become a successful woman, and at Pace I learned how to begin the journey. I encourage other girls to attend Pace to learn about themselves and to see they have the potential to become something great. I want to be an inspiration to others and let them know that you truly can become who you want to be in life. It all starts with you."

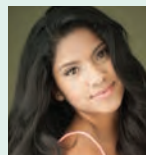


Emerald - Jacksonville

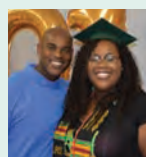
really proud of my accomplishments. I graduated high school with honors, and now I'm attending Jacksonville University in hopes of one day becoming a pediatrician."

"When I came to Pace, I had a lot of anger and hardly any confidence or self-esteem.

It took some time for me to trust the Pace program and staff, but once I did, I began noticing all the positive changes in myself. I accomplished so many things after my counselors taught me skills to help balance my emotions. I began making grades I'd never seen before and never thought I would; I earned A's, B's, and even student of the week!

After Pace, I earned my Early Childhood Education degree from Tallahassee Community College, a degree in criminal justice with a minor in psychology from Florida A&M and now work as a corrections officer. Because of the strong, passionate staff at Pace and my will to change, I am centered and balanced. I am prepared to embrace everything I am faced with in my life."

Cynthia - Miami

"When I came to Pace, I was failing school and a year behind. I was depressed and feeling completely lost. While I originally came to Pace to bring up my grades, Pace has helped me so much emotionally as well. I learned that when you fall down and you think you'll never get back up, Pace reaches out to pull you back up. The Pace staff goes the extra mile to help you succeed. They have really become my second home. I'm excited to say that I graduated this year as a Pace valedictorian, and I am currently studying computer science at Miami Dade College."

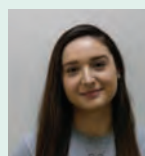


"Where do I even start? Pace has completely changed my life! When I transferred to Pace Orange from my public high school, I had a reputation for fighting, having bad grades, and skipping school. The first three weeks at Pace were tough because I wasn't ready to change. I was closed off, I didn't want to talk, I was just angry. But with the constant encouragement I felt around me every day, I began to really open up. I started actively participating in class, joined the Girls Leadership Council, became a Big Sister, and spent the summer on field trips and with mentors through Pace Orange's Dare to Dream program. Candi - Palm Beach

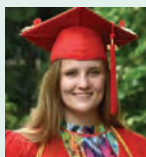
"Before I came to Pace, I would describe myself as quiet, hurt, and withdrawn. After being sexually abused by my stepfather and removed from my home, I turned to drugs and alcohol. But after a few months at Pace, I could feel my life start to change. I was building trusting relationships with staff and peers. Soon, I was helping other girls cope with their circumstances. I found my voice at Pace, and it feels really good to make a difference in their lives."



Gina - Pinellas

"When I arrived at Pace in August 2015, I was dealing with severe anxiety and depression.

I had not attended school in the past two years, and the only supportive people in my life were my grandmother and my aunt, but even those relationships were strained. My aunt heard about Pace and thought it would be a great option for me, and she was right! I enrolled and immediately got the supportive environment I needed. It was important to me to work hard to make my grandmother proud. I excelled quickly, earned straight A's, and caught up two grade levels. I was really proud of myself and started feeling like I could handle traditional high school again, so I left Pace and transitioned back into public school. It went well at first, but then my grandmother died unexpectedly, then shortly after that my mom was arrested. I had to drop out of school to take care of my 4-year-old brother. I was devastated and fell back into a depression. I called the one place I knew could help me get back on track with my goals. I reenrolled at Pace in August 2018 and am so happy. Now that my grandmother is no longer here, Pace is my only family. I am on track to graduate one year early and plan to attend college and major in English literature."



Katie - Manatee

"When my parents divorced, I struggled with separation anxiety, grief, and loss, which led to low motivation towards school. But April 27,

2015, changed my life for the better. I entered the Pace program and found the motivation, self-love, worth, and support I needed from family and Pace staff. I was beyond blessed to be a Pace girl, and it will be something I'll be forever proud to say. They provided me with the most amazing counselor who improved my communication skills, the love I have for myself, and taught me to always stand up for myself; to never let anxiety get in the way and when it does, ways to cope. Every staff member knows your name, they make you feel welcome and loved. Thank you, Pace, for giving me opportunity, letting me run with it, encouraging and providing me with anything and everything needed to succeed! Once a Pace Girl Always a Pace Girl."



Michaela - Marion

"I came to Pace as a 16-year-old mom. During my time at Pace, I worked closely with the counselor and advisor to earn credits

toward graduation, while also learning how to advocate for myself and my child in a positive way. I was able to complete all of my graduation requirements while at Pace and in August 2018, I earned my diploma! Now, I am in the process of starting the nursing program at College of Central Florida. If you are a teen mom, never give up - your dreams can become a reality too!"

"Life was rough for a while. My parents got divorced, then the new father figure in my life was murdered. After that, our family became homeless and ended up living in a house where meth was being produced and distributed. Once I was displaced again, I just completely dropped out of school. But then I found Pace Volusia-Flagler, where I found the hope and the potential to overcome the circumstances I had been dealt. I found the strength I needed to excel academically and chase my goals. Now, I am a general chemistry major on scholarship at the University of North Florida and dream of teaching and helping others any way I can."

"I attended high school but decided to drop out as soon as I turned 16. My depression and anxiety took such a toll on me that I began to doubt myself. At 17, I went on a tour of Pace. Later I got a call and was told I was accepted. Who I was two years ago compared to who I am now is astonishing. My depression and anxiety are still present, but I have learned coping skills and had an amazing support system while being there. I didn't think I'd graduate, and I'm proud to say that I graduated in May."



Dystani - Treasure Coast

"My life was spiraling out of control when I found Pace. Behavior problems, defiance, and poor coping skills manifested in chronic runaway behavior, school failure, and a battery charge. I entered Pace missing 10th grade credits but tested on the college level. Growth and change came slowly, but I began to transform with the help of my counselor and teachers. My growth led to serving as Vice President of Student Council, participation in the County Youth Leadership Council, membership in the Spoken Word/Poetry Club, and representing Pace in Tallahassee. I graduated from high school in May 2018 and was accepted into Indian River State College."



Mia - Pasco

"After getting involved with the wrong crowd and struggling with substance abuse issues at age 16, I found Pace Pasco. While there, I got caught up on school and even managed to graduate high school a year early with a 3.4 GPA. I also earned a leadership position within the countywide Safe Teens Against Drugs (STAND) group. My next adventure will include traveling to South America to volunteer and learn about different cultures. When I return, I want to become a math teacher and work at Pace! As we say, 'Once a Pace girl, always a Pace girl.'"
