Pace envisions a world where all girls have POWER, in a JUST and EQUITABLE society.

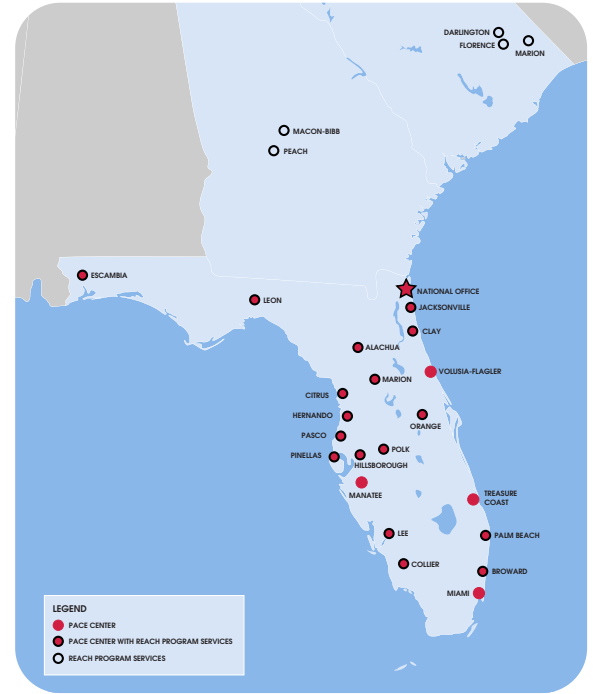
