OUR NEEDS

Campaign Goal: \$1 million Our capital improvement campaign will cover the costs of:

PRIORITY 1: SAFETY & SECURITY

- Creating a secure visitor entrance and front office that provides an added layer of security for staff and students.
- Total roof replacement to mitigate leaks and extensive damage from Hurricane lan.
- Install intercom system that allows staff to effectively communicate and share urgent messages throughout the building.
- Install exterior and interior cameras for extra security for staff and students.

PRIORITY 2: HEALTH & WELLNESS

- Expand Reach therapy suite to provide more offices and space to host student therapy sessions.
- Repair and upgrade parking lot asphalt to add outdoor recreational space including basketball court and seating for counseling sessions.
- Replace HVAC clean-air units to ensure clean, filtered air is circulated throughout the building.
- Install rear gate for emergency exit in recreational space.
