
MISSION:

BEFORE PACE

71% Were failing one or more classes prior to attending Pace

17% Were previously involved with the juvenile justice system

62% Were suspended or expelled prior to Pace

AFTER PACE

80% Improved academically at Pace

82% Had no involvement with the juvenile justice system after one year

66% Girls were in school, higher education or employed after one year

REACH PROGRAM SERVICES

Pace Reach Program Services is a therapeutic and counseling program offering social, emotional, behavioral health and support services for girls ages 11-17 and their families. Reach therapists travel to girls to provide services in their home, school, community or online.


